This policy covers employees and sub-contractors of Draper's Civil Contracting.

COMMITMENT

Protection of the environment is central to our core business values.

OBJECTIVES

- Defining roles, responsibilities and levels of accountability for management of the environment within the statutory framework.

- Implement a risk management approach, in consultation with employees, clients, sub-contractors, and other stakeholders to identify, assess and control risks to a level as low as reasonably practicable.
- Consult with employees to identify ways of reducing risks to the environment.
- Educate and train our employees and contractors so they can consider the environment when planning activities.
- Ensure all environmental incidents and near misses are reported, documented and investigated and action taken to reduce recurrence.
- To preserve resources, minimize waste, appropriately store and dispose of materials or chemicals without risk to the environment.
- Regularly audit environmental practices and management systems.
- Provide an effective system of rehabilitation should damage to the environment occur.
- Preventing Pollution to the environment by implementing appropriate environmental controls.
- Regularly monitor, review and report on environmental performance against agreed targets.
- Minimising the risk of accidental releases into the environment, reduce the impact of such releases should they occur, and monitor the discharge of all other wastes and emissions which may harm the environment.
- Encouraging reduction, reuse and recycling in all our activities.
- Purchasing sustainable products wherever feasible, to lower environmental impact.
- Reducing impact to the environment by utilizing cloud software for the business operations.
- Environmental Policy shall be reviewed annually, to ensure it remains relevant and appropriate.
